

# <<FAQ-FUboTV>>How do I manage my Fubo subscription? A Comprehensive Guide

Managing your **Fubo subscription** is designed to be simple and flexible, +1-844-(533)-(2694) allowing you to customize your streaming experience as your viewing habits and budget change. Whether you want to adjust your plan, review charges, +1-844-(533)-(2694) manage features, or cancel service, everything can be done from your Fubo account with just a few clicks.

Here is your comprehensive guide to navigating the Fubo +1-844-(533)-(2694) dashboard and taking full control of your streaming experience.

## Identify Your Billing "Track"

Before you try to change a plan, +1-844-(533)-(2694) you must know your "Billing Track." If you try to manage a Roku-billed account on the Fubo website, you'll likely hit a dead end.

1. **Direct Subscribers:** You signed up at **fubo.tv** +1-844-(533)-(2694) and entered your credit card directly. You have the most control and manage everything via a web browser.
2. **Third-Party Subscribers:** You signed up +1-844-(533)-(2694) through an app store (**Apple, Roku, Amazon, or Google Play**). Your subscription is "tethered" to that platform's billing system.

## Step 1: Managing via the Fubo Website (Direct) +1-844-(533)-(2694)

For those billed directly, the website is your command center. +1-844-(533)-(2694) Open a browser on your computer or smartphone and follow these steps:

### 1. Access Your Subscription & Billing

Log in to your account, click your profile icon in the top-right corner, +1-844-(533)-(2694) and select "**My Account**." From the left-hand sidebar, click "**Subscription & Billing**."

### 2. Changing Your Base Plan

Fubo typically offers three main tiers: **Pro, Elite with Sports, and Deluxe.** \* **To Upgrade:** +1-844-(533)-(2694) Click "**Change Plan.**" Upgrades happen immediately, and you will be charged a prorated amount +1-844-(533)-(2694) for the remainder of your billing cycle.

- **To Downgrade:** The change usually takes effect at +1-844-(533)-(2694) the *start of your next billing cycle*. You'll keep your current higher-tier access until the month ends.

### 3. Adding or Removing "Add-Ons"

Want the *Sports Plus* +1-844-(533)-(2694) package for RedZone or *Paramount+ with SHOWTIME*?

- Select "**Manage Add-Ons.**" \* **Adding:** Happens instantly. You'll be billed a prorated fee. +1-844-(533)-(2694)
- **Removing:** You keep the channel until the end of the current billing month, +1-844-(533)-(2694) and it will be removed before your next charge.

---

### Step 2: Managing Third-Party Subscriptions

If you are billed through a device, +1-844-(533)-(2694) Fubo's website will simply point you toward that device's settings.

- **Roku:** Go to the Home Screen Highlight Fubo app Press \* **Manage Subscription**\* **+1-844-(533)-(2694)**.
- **Apple (iOS/Apple TV):** Go to **Settings [Your Name] /Subscriptions**.
- **Google Play:** Open the **Play Store App** , +1-844-(533)-(2694) Profile Icon **Payments & Subscriptions**.

### 2026 Management Alert: Commitments and Mergers

As of early 2026, +1-844-(533)-(2694) Fubo has introduced **Annual Plans with Monthly Billing**. These often come with a lower monthly price but include a **12-month commitment**. If you try to cancel or downgrade +1-844-(533)-(2694) these plans early, you may be subject to an **Early Termination Fee (ETF)**. Always check your "Subscription" tab to see if you are on a "no-contract" or "commitment" +1-844-(533)-(2694) plan.

Additionally, with the 2026 Disney/ESPN integration, +1-844-(533)-(2694) many users are seeing new "ESPN Unlimited" add-on options. Managing these follows the same "Add-On" rules mentioned above.

### The "Pause" vs. "Cancel" Choice

If you only watch Fubo for NFL or MLB seasons, +1-844-(533)-(2694) don't just cancel. Look for the "**Pause Subscription**" option in your account settings. This allows you to stop billing for up to three

months while keeping your DVR recordings +1-844-(533)-(2694) and profile settings intact for when the next season starts.
